As a body, we will seek to integrate into mainstream psychotherapy training, literature and practice.

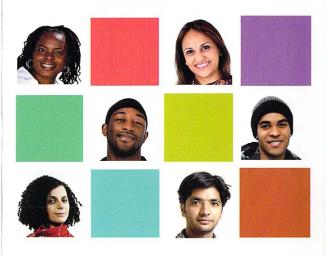
